#### Huntersville Greenway Connections

- All Huntersville residents will have the ability to come downtown via greenway and sidewalk connections
- Huntersville, Cornelius, and Davidson will be connected via greenway
- Huntersville will be the mid-point of the NC/SC state line to Statesville Seam trail

As part of Downtown planning, we have an opportunity to consider features that would make Huntersville a greenway destination


# Greenway Trail and Bikeway Commission Spine of the Vine Vision



- Goal is to add 14 miles of greenway creating north/south and east/west Huntersville connections by 2030
- Currently 11 miles/80% of goal is funded and targeted for completion from now through 2026
- GTBC is working to have the remaining miles prioritized for completion by 2030 or sooner
- GTBC is also working with the town to complete **sidewalk gaps** connecting every neighborhood, school, park, and major shopping center into the greenway by 2030 or sooner.
- The greenway and sidewalk connectivity goal will result in every Huntersville neighborhood being connected to our Downtown

#### Huntersville Funded Greenways with Target Dates








#### Connectivity to Cornelius and Davidson

- Tunnel opening and North Meck Park Greenway completion will connect the downtowns of Huntersville, Cornelius, and Davidson
- Current projections show these connections being completed in 2023 and 2024
- This will open up a network of greenways and multi-use paths between Huntersville, Cornelius, and Davidson

#### Connections to Davidson and Cornelius with Target Dates








### Mecklenburg County 'Seam' Trail

- The Mecklenburg County Seam trail is planned to connect from the NC/SC state line to Statesville, running in close proximity to 115
- This trail will be about 50 miles long and projected to be the longest trail in the area.
- The mid-point will be downtown Huntersville
- Current Status: A planning study has been funded in partnership with NCDOT and the Jurisdictions to advance the implementation of the trail
